Meetings will be held the second Wednesday of the month at the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, City Park, Hagerstown, Maryland, 10 a.m. to about 12 p.m., September to June or by zoom.

- January 13, 2021 Designing Huck structures with creativity and color, Karel Henneberger. Bring huck examples woven on 4 or more shafts.

- March 10, 2021 Take Shadow Weave Out of the Shadows, Barbara Diefenderfer. Bring shadow weave samples to show.
- April 14, 2021 The Techniques of Free Form Woven Design, Terry Edwards.
- May 12, 2021 Color and Dye Ideas for Yarns in Primary and Secondary Colors, Deb Lawson. This is in preparation for a dye workshop at the June meeting.
- June 9, 2021 Dyed Warp Workshop using Cellulose Fibers, Deb Lawson. Preparation instructions will follow. You will bring a prepared warp to dye. There will be a fee for this workshop.
- Tablescapes We plan to participate in this virtual program in February. Plans to follow.

Programs will be at the museum when it is possible but until then we will meet by zoom. Beginning in October the program presentations will be zoomed from the art classroom at the museum with consideration for those who are unable to connect by zoom.
