Our Next Free Lecture - Open to All

March 28, 2023, 7p.m.: Free Your Mind - Public Textile Social Justice Art Project, with Theda Sandiford

Free Your Mind is a public textile art project aiming to collect, exhibit, embed and release personal narratives about Microaggressions in a multi-sensory installation.



Microaggressions are subtle, intentional, and oftentimes unintentional, everyday interactions or behaviors that communicate hostile, derogatory or negative messages or assumptions toward historically marginalized groups. The weight of these daily interactions underpins very real consequences... stress, anger, frustration, self-doubt and ultimately feelings of powerlessness and invisibility. This project exposes these interactions to provide a release for the viewer.

Theda Sandiford is an award-winning self-taught fiber and installation artist based in Jersey City, NJ. Community art making is key to her process. Theda curates' multi-disciplinary experiences pairing people, sound and art making to create a safe space to explore themes such as equity & inclusion, sustainability, and personal wellbeing.
