MAFA Conference 2025

MAFA 2025 will be held June 26-29, 2025 at Millersville University, Millersville, PA



Planning for 2025 is already underway! We have several open positions on the conference planning committee and we're asking Reps to help us get the word out to guild members. For 2025, we particularly need volunteers to take on the following important committee roles:

- Ads and Donations Coordinator contact advertisers and organizations, and manage submitted ads and donations. Skills needed: good communications, spreadsheets, and email.
- **Volunteer Coordinator** coordinate and manage volunteers before the conference and onsite. Skills needed: good communications, spreadsheets, email, and willing to learn Signup Genius.
- **Weekend Classes Coordinator** solicit, schedule, and coordinate up to a dozen 2 to 3 hour classes for day trippers on Friday afternoon and Saturday during the conference. Skills needed: good communications, experience scheduling guild instructors helpful, spreadsheets, and email.
- **Goody Bags Coordinator** collect and sort goodies donated by guilds so they are ready to stuff in the conference totes. Skills needed: willing to attend MDSW and have items shipped to you, organize helpers to sort goodies, deliver everything to the conference, and email.
